

Bernard Francis McCONVILLE



Pre-enlistment:

- Bernard McConville was born in Orange NSW to parents: Bernard and Maria McCONVILLE of Orange
- His occupation was that of a painter who lived in Toowoomba, Queensland as a single man
- His next of kin was his brother, James McConville, Trades Hall, Goulburn, New South Wales

Military Records

- Service Number: 4742
- Bernard McConville enlisted on 19 August 1915 in Toowoomba, Qld as a Private with the 25th Battalion, 12th Reinforcement
- On 12 April 1916 he embarked with his Unit on RMS Mooltan, from Sydney, aged 25 years
- His last Unit was the 25th Infantry Battalion
- His war service was in the Campaign on the Western Front
- Private Bernard Francis McConville was killed in action, France, 14 November 1916, aged 27 years
